# Summer Camp in China

Intensive Mandarin learning in a safe and supervised environment. Students study Mandarin in the morning, followed by an afternoon of fun activities. On Saturdays we run day trip excursions.

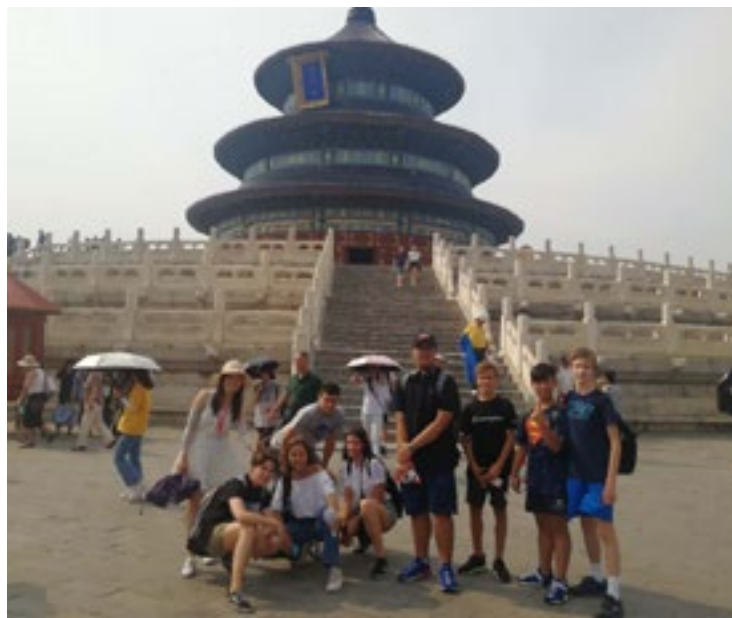

# Introduction

From Monday to Friday participants study Chinese starting at 9am. The class is followed by afternoon activities, which include a wide variety of options, ranging from Chinese paper cutting to Shaolin Kung Fu lessons.

Every Saturday we go for a day trip, visiting the Great Wall, going to the Summer Palace, and visiting other attractions in Beijing.

## Homestay Camp

for 11-17 years old

Accommodation is with a Chinese homestay family, experiencing Chinese life firsthand, while practicing language skills and discovering the world of Chinese culture. From Monday to Saturday breakfast and dinner are taken with the host family and lunch at the school.

On Sundays all meals are with the family and the student can participate in family trips and social activities, which often includes playing badminton or hiking trips to the mountains around China's Great Wall. All students live in single rooms.

## Residence Camp

for 11-17 years old

Accommodation is in the LTL Residence, together with other Summer Program participants in shared rooms. A program coordinator lives with the participants, organizing activities, support and supervision during the program. Students eat all meals together, either at home, at the school or at a local restaurant in the area.

## Day Camp

for 7-17 years old

The student participates in all classes and social activities but stays with his or her parents at night and on Sundays. Includes lunch at the school and during weekend trips, transport to the school can be arranged, depending on location.

---

## Half Day Camp

for 7-17 years old

Students stay with their parents and join the summer camp Chinese classes every day, but not the afternoon and weekend activities. Perfect for students who live in Beijing and know the city but want to give their Mandarin a quick boost over the holidays.

## Family Packages

Parents can accompany their children to Beijing and either study a Chinese language course on their own, share accommodation with their child or take a break and explore China while their child is at the summer camp. Please enquire with us for a tailor-made program for you and your family.

Participants can join the camp on any starting date throughout the eight weeks. Students can choose to study for any preferred length of time, from one week to the whole eight week program. For students who want to stay longer or arrive earlier, extension programs can be offered.

For Homestay and Residential Camp participants arrival is always on Sunday and departure on Saturday, but it is possible to book additional nights if needed.

For one week programs a full Saturday activity is included. It is possible to book an additional day of accommodation if late check out or Sunday departure is needed.
