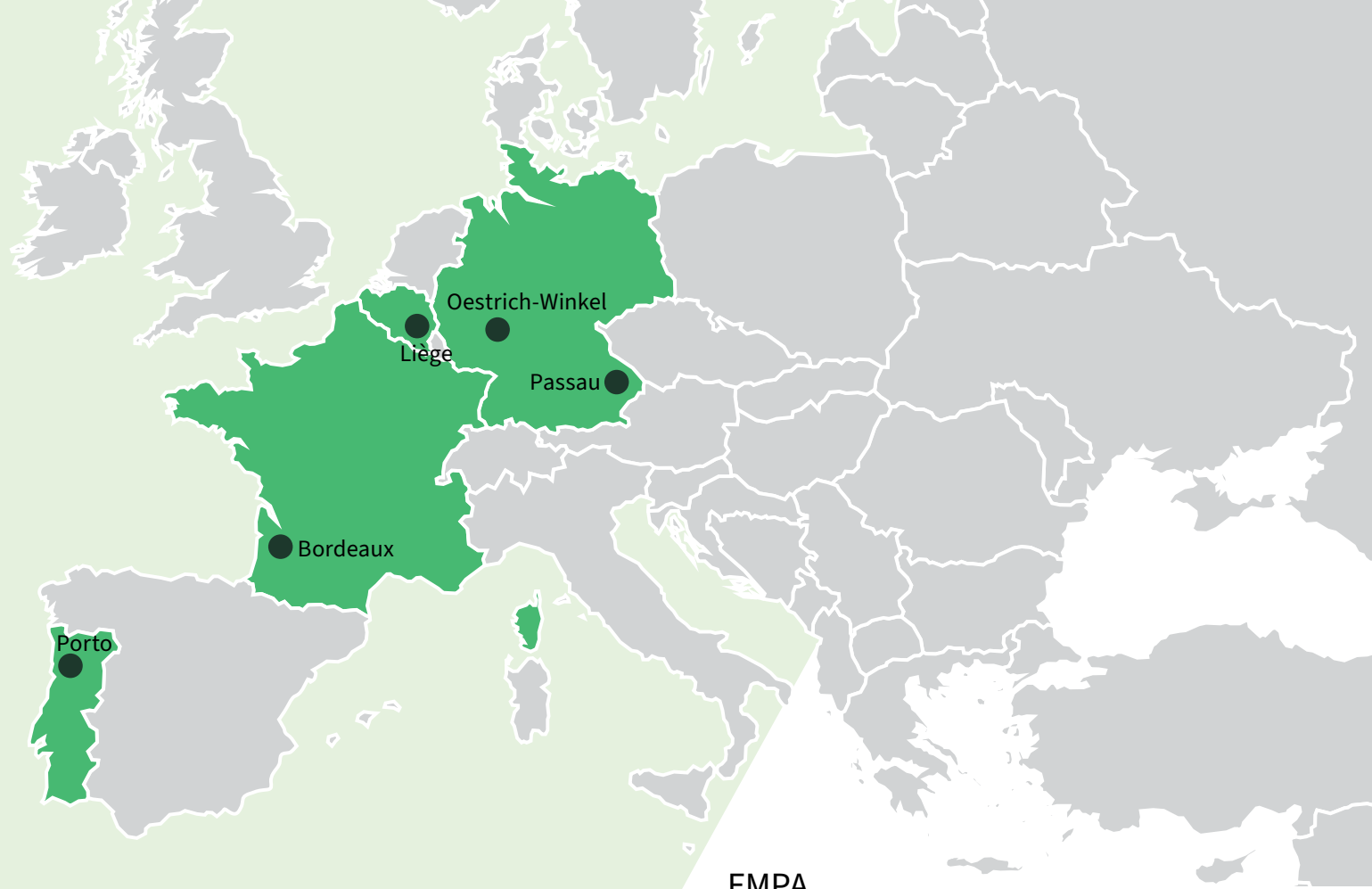
### DSG

At Bachelor's level on the DSG (Deutschsprachiger Studiengang in BWL), students can study business subjects in German, learn from lecturers from the University of Passau, and obtain an additional German-language certificate. This option is available in several English-language programmes: Applied Economics, Business and Management, Business Informatics,

International Business, and Data Science in Business. At the Master's level, students can spend a full academic year at the University of Passau and earn a double degree, receiving both the University of Passau's Master of Business Administration and their Corvinus diploma. Find more details in the double degree section above.

### EMPA

EMPA (European Master in Public Administration) is an academic cooperation between the Master's programmes of European universities offering education in Public Administration and Public Policy. As a student of the Public Policy and Management Master's Programme, you could spend one semester abroad within this framework. Upon successful completion of the courses prescribed by the partner university and approved by Corvinus, you will receive an official EMPA Certificate, signed by both your home and host universities.

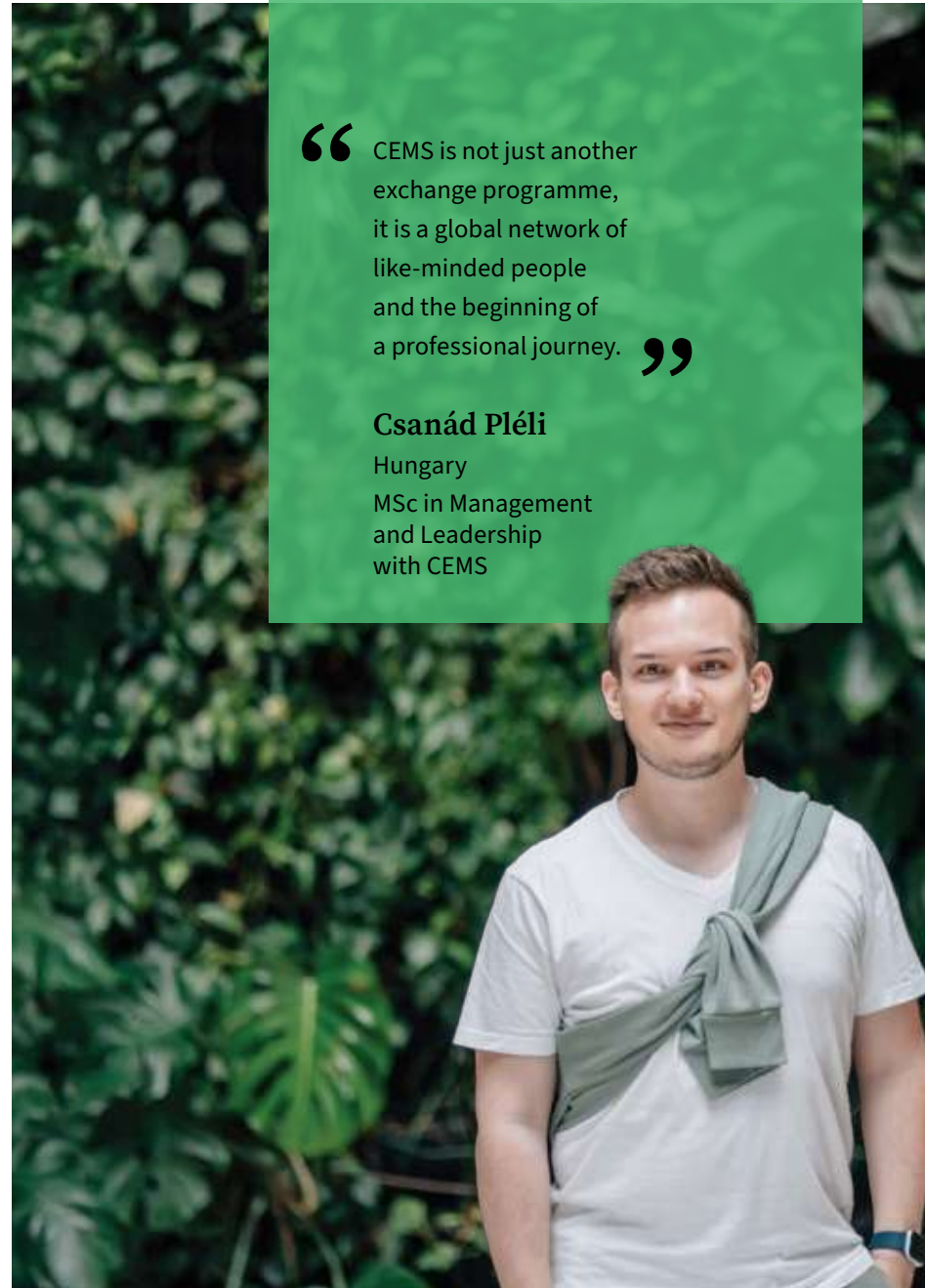

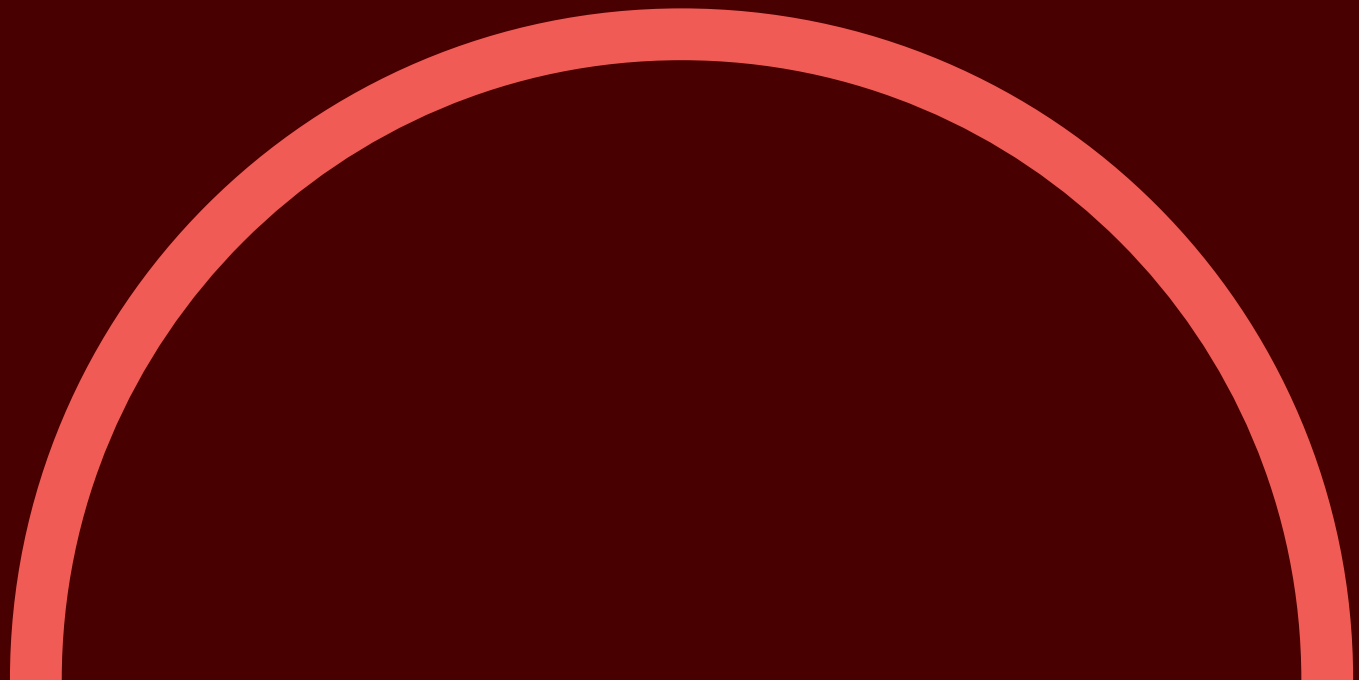
