Objective of the 2025-2026 SEK SCHOLARSHIPS:

Starting from the standards that define excellence for SEK International Schools and within the SEK competency framework:

Contribute to the educational development of students whose profiles are aligned with the SEK competency profile to start or continue their study programme at a prestigious educational institution, recognised for its excellence in both the different modalities of Baccaulaureate and the International Baccaulaureate (IB) Diploma Programme through its SEK university Baccaulaureate model.

To collaborate so that young people can combine their sporting skills with their academic training, through a comprehensive supervised programme for athletes with a good performance at SEK International Schools with recognised professional experience in this field.

Develop and value effort and overcoming of adversity and community action for the benefit of society in general.

Who can apply for a scholarship from SEK International Schools and the Felipe Segovia Foundation?

SEK Excellence Scholarships: All students in year 4 of Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) or its equivalent if the student comes from another educational system, with excellent competency growth both academically and personally, who wish to expand and enrich their education through the SEK University Baccaulaureate, through the **International Baccaulaureate** (IB) Diploma Programme or any form of Baccaulaureate that the SEK schools offer, and who meet the required requirements. In this edition, we also want to recognise the artistic talent of those students who wish to study the SEK University Baccaulaureate in the Arts modality at one of the authorised SEK schools.

SEK SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPORTS PERFORMANCE: All SEK students from year 5 Primary Education to year 2 Baccalaureate, who stand out for their sports performance, representing their school in different competitions, or for their sports projection in the sport they practice, in this last case, whether or not they represent their school, and who meet the required requirements.

SEK SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPORTING TALENT: All SEK students, whether or not they represent the schools or club at a sports level, and who can demonstrate a high sporting talent.

María de Villota Scholarships for Personal Effort: All SEK Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) students or its equivalent if the student comes from another education system, demonstrating an excellent academic record, capacity for work and overcoming difficulties and having developed and led initiatives with impact in the Community, following María de Villota's example and meeting the stipulated requirements.

Felipe Segovia Award to SEK students: All year 4 students in Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) at SEK, with excellent competency growth both academically and personally, who wish to expand and enrich their education through the SEK University Baccalaureate, through the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme or any Baccalaureate modality that SEK schools offer, and best represent the values of the SEK International Schools and its Founder Felipe Segovia.

1. - SEK Excellence Scholarships

SEK International Schools, through the Felipe Segovia Foundation, aim to support students in year 4 of Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) or its equivalent if the student comes from another educational system, with a high academic and personal competency profile to study the **SEK University Baccalaureate** through the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme or any of the Baccalaureate modalities, at one of its authorised SEK schools.

Requirements

1. Have studied year 4 of Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) or its equivalent during the 2024-2025 academic year.
2. Have obtained an average mark of 9 points in ESO year 3 and the first and second assessments for year 4 or its equivalent in other education systems.
3. Show evidence that the student continues to be committed to their growth and development, constantly striving to achieve a competency profile that aligns with the following established standards of excellence:
 - 3.1. Learning Management: knowing how to set clear goals, plan their studies effectively and adjust their approach as they progress.
 - 3.2. Problem Solving: ability to tackle new challenges, analyse situations and reach their own conclusions, using creative thinking that takes them out of their comfort zone.
 - 3.3. Motivation and Personal Growth: show constant interest in lifelong learning, actively seek learning resources and demonstrate that they are adaptable and curious.
 - 3.4. Wellbeing: having skills to take care of oneself, manage one's emotions, maintain healthy habits and use internet safety measures.
 - 3.5. Perseverance and Adaptability: demonstrate that you keep moving forward, adapt and always seek to improve, even when faced with challenges.

- 3.6. Purpose and Motivation: having a clear reason to achieve their goals, being motivated and aware of their thoughts and personal contributions.
- 3.7. Effective communication: Being good at expressing oneself orally and in writing, in addition to understanding non-verbal communication and how to handle digital content.
- 3.8. Leadership and collaboration: demonstrate skills to lead and work with others, taking responsibility according to the situation, fostering group agreements and valuing the qualities of others.
- 3.9. Teamwork: knowing how to work with others, understanding their interests, promoting participation and acting with honesty and transparency.
- 3.10. Intercultural Empathy and Ecological Awareness: understanding and appreciating the perspectives of different people, and having the ability to evaluate and prevent the ecological impact of their actions.

Benefits

Each of the SEK Excellence Scholarships will be awarded by the Scholarship Committee, based on the academic merits and the personal portfolio submitted by students.

Endowed with **50% of the cost of SEK university baccalaureate education, whether it is the Diploma Programme or any baccalaureate option chosen within the SEK educational offer, over two years.**

The Scholarship Committee may review and even completely withdraw the scholarship to the student, if one of the following circumstances occurs:

- owing money to SEK International Schools.
- a significant drop in the student's academic performance.
- an attitude not in keeping with the values of SEK International Schools. (Coexistence, academic propriety, effort, overcoming difficulties, etc.)

Two annual reviews will be carried out: one in the first half of January and another in the first half of April. Students will only be notified once when their conditions of the awarded scholarship change.

Documentation

- Academic certificate in year 3 ESO or its equivalent in the case that the student comes from another education system and the qualifications corresponding to the first and second assessment of year 4 of ESO or its equivalent, issued by the school of origin.
- A full personal portfolio submitted by students including:
 - Personal letter in which the student outlines their motivations for applying for the scholarship and for studying the SEK University Baccalaureate, either the IB Diploma Programme or a Baccalaureate modality within the educational offer, in schools authorised to offer it.
- Curriculum Vitae detailing with evidence:
 - Languages you are proficient in, your level of competence and experience in stays abroad for the purpose of learning/consolidating a language.
 - Description of projects (scientific, social, entrepreneurial, technological) in which they have participated, highlighting their contribution and the results obtained. They can include images, graphics or links to projects they have carried out.
 - Details about their involvement in clubs, sports, art schools, summer courses or other extracurricular activities outside the academic sphere.
 - Experience in volunteering projects, service and commitment to the community highlighting the transferable

skills acquired.

- A section that showcases their passions, hobbies and interests.
- Recognitions, awards or special mentions that have been presented.

In the event that a student opts for the Arts Baccalaureate, they must present an artistic portfolio where they show their trajectory in one of the artistic disciplines (music, dance, theatre, digital arts) and significant evidence that reflects their talent and creativity.

- At least two letters of recommendation from school teachers and extracurricular activities supervisors, that make reference to their competency profile.

All student candidates must post the required documentation at the following address and such documentation must be in **Spanish or English**:

Extension of the scholarship

The upkeep of the scholarship during the two-year duration period of the Diploma Programme or to take any Baccalaureate studies is subject to compliance with the requirements and conditions in terms of both academic performance and personal profile.

Resolution

Students will be notified of the decision of the Scholarship Committee in writing before **23 May 2025**

The Scholarship Committee's decision is final.



2.- SEK SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPORTS PERFORMANCE

These scholarships are intended to recognise those student athletes who study at one of the schools of SEK International School and who stand out for their sporting performance, representing their school in various competitions, or for their sporting projection in the sport they practice, in the latter case, they may be new students, representing their school or not.

Academic performance will also be valued, understanding that one of the key objectives pursued with these scholarships is the compatibility of the school stage with the educational one, providing the student with everything necessary, including the personalised adaptation of their study plan, so that they can grow at a sports level without having to give up their formal academic education.

In short, the aim is to value the active practice and projection of the athlete from a comprehensive point of view.

Requirements

- To have a valid federal license and to certify, through a certificate from the Federation, their participation in competitions in the year prior to the application for the scholarship.
- Comply with the sports criteria established for each sport.
- Certify ranking or times with a certificate issued by the Federation.
- Having an appropriate academic record in which a mark equal to or higher than 5 must be accredited in each and every one of the subjects taken.
- To have a representative profile of sports ethics and personal development. The teaching team at their school must validate the academic and personal progress aspects, and the sports team (coaches, monitors ...) must validate the candidate's sports ethics.

Benefits

Each of the SEK Sports Scholarships will be awarded by the Scholarship Committee, based on the sporting merits and the personal portfolio submitted by students.

A scholarship ranging from 30% to 50% applicable to the cost of the sports activity can be opted for, as long as there are candidates who meet the criteria established in the rules. In addition, a scholarship will be provided, covering between 15% and 25% more of the cost of education.

The Scholarship Committee may review the awarded amounts and even completely withdraw the scholarship to the student, if one of the following circumstances occurs:

- A debit position with SEK International School .
- A significant drop in the student's academic performance.
- An attitude not in accordance with the values of SEK International School. (Coexistence, academic propriety, sporting ethics, effort, overcoming difficulties, etc.)

Two annual reviews will be carried out: one in the first half of January 2026 and another in the first half of April 2026. Students will only be notified once when their conditions of the awarded scholarship change.

Documentation

- Academic certificate of the studies carried out. You must include the marks related to the year prior to the scholarship application.
- Documents proving participation and level in the sport for which they are applying for the scholarship.

A certificate of marks accredited and signed by the corresponding federation must be submitted, no other document containing the marks will be valid. A document obtained from the official website of the corresponding Federation will be allowed as long as it is stamped and signed.

Such certificate must take into account the assessment of participations and the results obtained up to two months before the date set for the communication of the resolution of the SCHOLARSHIPS. In the event that the competitions were after that publication date, the partitions and results from the previous season can be accredited.

A full **personal portfolio** submitted by students including:

- Letter in which the student states his or her motivations for applying for the scholarship and for studying at one of the SEK International Schools.
- Sports curriculum: Position in ranking and report from the student's sports programme manager.
- Curriculum Vitae: Languages, courses, extracurricular activities, volunteer activities, hobbies, etc.

3.- SEK SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPORTING TALENT

SEK International Schools, through its Felipe Segovia Foundation, aims to recognise student athletes from its schools who stand out for their sports development and growth projection and for their commitment to improving their personal and academic profile.

Requirements

- Students studying from year 5 Primary to SEK University Baccalaureate.
- Have obtained an average mark of 7 points in ESO year 3 and the first and second assessments of the current year. An official marks certificate proving this point must be submitted.
- Possess a valid federation license and accredit by means of a certificate from the Federation its participation in the different competitions, tournaments, leagues or championships, as well as the seniority as a member of the federation in the sport for which the scholarship is requested.
- Meet the established sports criteria for subsequent evaluation.
 1. Seniority as a member of a federation in the sport for which the scholarship is requested.
 2. Participation in different national and international championships, tournaments, competitions and leagues.
- To prove by means of a certificate issued by the Federation, their participation history at federative level and their seniority as a federated member.
- Show evidence of their personal profile.

Procedure

This scholarship will be awarded by the Scholarship Committee, based on the students' academic and sporting merits.

A score will be established based on the accredited merits, both sporting and academic. Once the scores of all candidates have been obtained, they will be arranged from highest to lowest score. Based on the score obtained, the corresponding monetary amount will be assigned to that score.

The Scholarship Committee may review and even completely withdraw the scholarship to the student, if one of the following circumstances occurs:

- owing money to SEK International Schools.
- a significant drop in the student's academic performance.
- an attitude not in keeping with the values of SEK International Schools. (Coexistence, academic propriety, effort, overcoming difficulties, etc.)

Two annual reviews will be carried out: one in the first half of January 2026 and another in the first half of April 2026. Students will only be notified once when their conditions of the awarded scholarship change.

Benefits

This scholarship is awarded by decision of the Felipe Segovia Foundation Board of Trustees, based on the SEK students selected for the SEK Excellence scholarship programme.

It is endowed with 100% of tuition fees for the Diploma Programme and 100% of complementary services: Meals service, transport service and boarding where appropriate.

The Board of Trustees may review and even completely withdraw the scholarship to the student, if one of the following circumstances occurs:

- a debit position with SEK International Schools.
- a significant drop in the student's academic performance.
- an attitude not in keeping with the values of SEK International Schools. (Coexistence, academic propriety, effort, overcoming difficulties, etc.)

For this there will be two revisions:

- First half of January 2026.
- First half of April 2026.

Students will only be notified once when their conditions of the awarded scholarship change.
