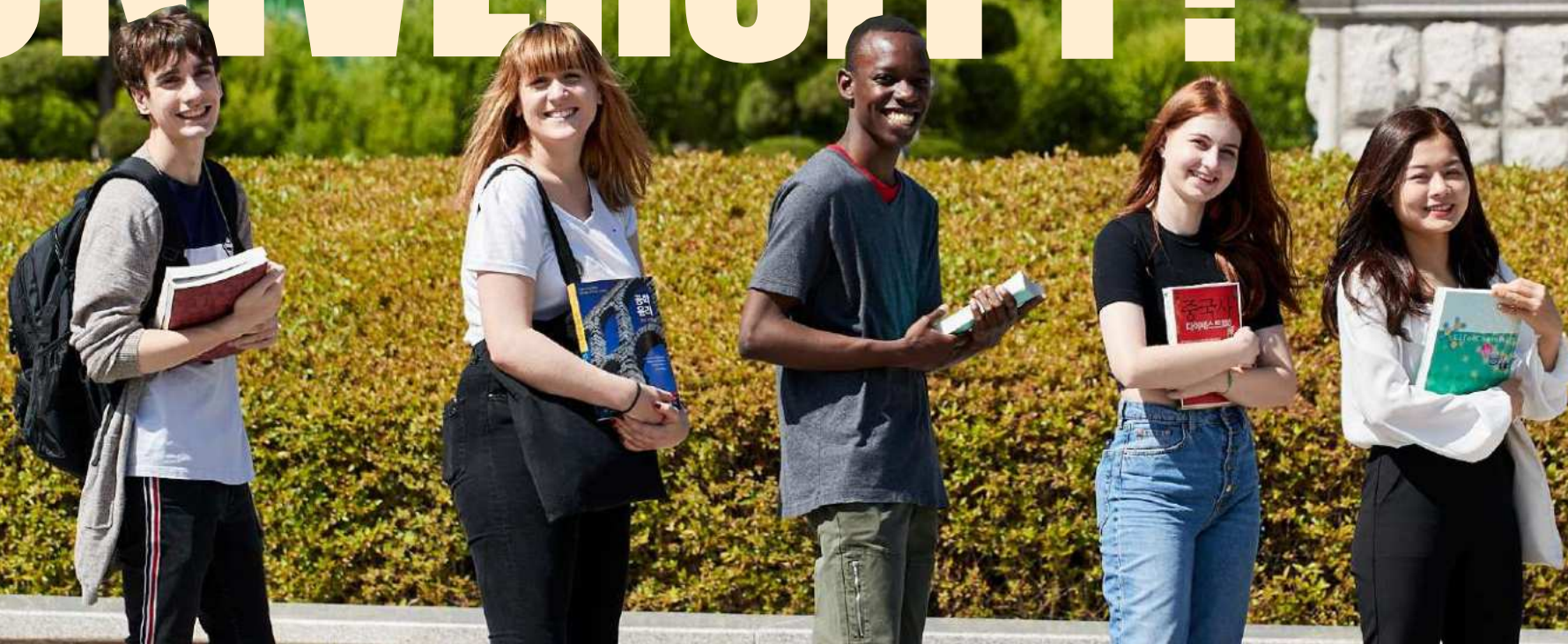

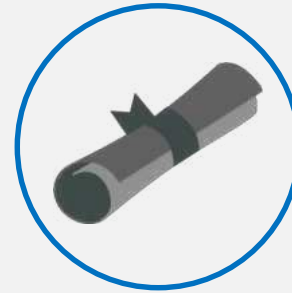

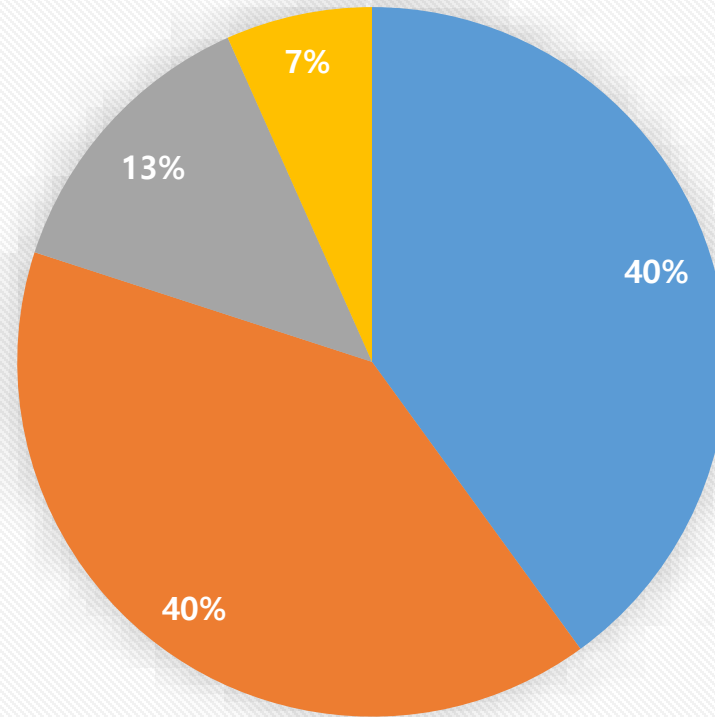

Outbound

6400 students have participated study abroad programs at 30 partner universities in 10 countries

Inbound

Exchange Student : one or two semesters and acquire transferable credits

Short-term (Visiting) Student : one or two semesters and acquire transferable credits

50% of tuition fees of Daejin University will be waived

Dual-degree Student : 2+2 or 3+1 models

Participants will be awarded Bachelor's degrees from both home and host universities upon successful completion of all requirements at each institution.

For the first semester at Daejin University, **50% of tuition will be waived.**

From the second semester, scholarship depends on the academic performance of the previous semester.

4.3 or higher : 100% of tuition

3.0 or higher : 40% of tuition

2.5 or higher : 20% of tuition (4.5 scale)

한글

(Hangul) is easy to read and write

It was created by Sejong the great in mid 15th century to expand literacy among the people and technically Hangul is an alphabet not a syllabary

The Korean alphabet contains 14 consonants and 10 vowels, and each symbol is simply the consonant letter combined with vowel letter

With the memorization of 31 letters, 11,172 variations of letters can be formed

Korean Learning Center

Korean Learning Center offers Korean language course on a year-round basis to language learners since its foundation in 2009

Approximately 1,300 international students from 23 countries have enrolled to the Korean Learning Center as a Second Language program

Through various activities and projects, students have opportunities to meet other students from different countries and cultures

Unique features of Korean Learning Center

Eco-Friendly Campus : surrounded Mt. Wang-bang, students may feel the nature of Korea by walking around campus

Low-Cost Education : low tuition costs compared to other institutions

Active Support : Faculty and staff members are willing to assist students in various ways

Visa Service : Korean Learning Center offers visa extension services for students

Korean as a Second Language Program

Consists of 6 levels students are given a choice from the beginner to advanced classes

Throughout the program, various cultural activities and customized programs are offered such as wearing Han-bok (traditional clothing), cooking Korean traditional food, visiting historic sites

Visiting International Student's home country

During the summer/winter break, international students return to their respective countries with Korean participants as a group and introduce culture, history, and life

All the expenses including flight, hotel, and insurance are given as scholarship
