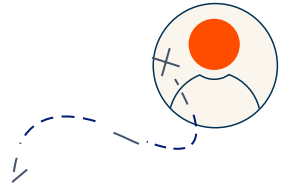




HAMELIN-LAIE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL ADMISSIONS PROCESS

APPLICATION

Submit an online application form, complete with supporting documents. There is no application fee.

MOTIVATION LETTER

We ask all secondary students applying to the school to submit a motivation letter which establishes their motives for studying in our school. In this letter, the student should state their study habits, level of autonomy, extracurricular activities, participation in competitions, volunteer campaigns, or any other relevant item.

PERSONAL INTERVIEW

Our Admissions team will arrange for a meeting with the family and our Senior Academic Team. The student applying will also have a personal, informal conversation-style interview with a member of the Secondary Academic team, which helps the school get to know the student and vice-versa.

ASSESSMENT

This oral and written exam is used to evaluate the student's general English level.

ENROLMENT

An offer of enrolment letter will be sent to families. Once you accept the admissions offer, pay the registration fee, sign the parent contract and complete the registration form.



REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

FORM TUTOR REPORT

This report should provide details about the student's academics as well as their general behaviour and attitude as a student.

ACADEMIC REPORTS

This should include the latest trimester/term marks and the students final marks from the previous academic year.

PERSONAL DOCUMENTS

The school requires copies of the following personal identification documents:

- Student's birth certificate
- Student's ID or passport
- Parents/Legal Guardians ID or passport
- One current photo of the student (headshot only)
- CatSalut health card
- RALC number of the student (must be provided by previous school if in Catalunya)

MOTIVATON LETTER

This letter should be written by the student applying and explain why they want to study in our school. It should also state their study habits, level of autonomy, extracurricular activities, participation in competitions, volunteer campaigns, or any other relevant item.
