Fees for international students

It is important to think about not only your tuition and accommodation costs but the cost of living too.

The minimum cost of living as recommended by UKVI for studying outside London is £1,136 per month, but will vary from student to student. This is a guideline to cover items like accommodation, food, laundry, books, clothes, toiletries and socialising. - Currently the maintenance level is set at £1,483/month for those studying in London and £1,136 for people studying outside of London.

Confirmation payment & tuition fees

Once you have received an offer of a place at the International Study Centre, you are required to pay a confirmation payment. The security deposit is held to cover damages and any other incidental expenses. Any monies left at the end of your programme will be returned to you. If you do not require a student visa you must pay this sum no later than 3 months before the start date of your programme.

28 days prior to start of 1 st term	Balance of 1 st and 2 nd term fees as set out in your offer letter
2 months prior to start of 2 nd term	Balance of 3 rd term fees (if any) as set out in your offer letter
