2. Submit Your Documents

The following documents are required to apply and accept your offer to INTO Illinois State:

- Copy of passport (and for spouse/dependents, if applicable)
- Copy of bank statement and Affidavit of Support or letter of sponsorship
- Copy of high school or university diploma (English and native language)
- Copies of transcripts of all relevant qualifications translated into English as well as in native language*
- Copies of TOEFL/IELTS/PTEA/Password*
- Copies of visa, I-20 and current DSO information (transfer students only)

*Transcripts and English language test scores are not required to apply to the English Language Program.

3. Confirm Your Place

If qualified, you will receive an offer of admission via email. After you return your signed acceptance form and paid the required deposit, we will send your I-20 to the shipping address provided.
